### What does it take to apply for the Improved Pension Benefit?

- Only 90 days of continuous, active duty military service, one of which was during wartime.
- Any discharge other than a dishonorable discharge.
- Disabled OR... at least age 65!

Nearly all Veterans or their Widows in assisted Living Facilities, or other Senior facilities, that are at least 65 would qualify yet only a small percentage of them are receiving the benefit. Generally they are simply unaware of their possible eligibility. Some Veterans or Widows in need of home care can also qualify. Even if a family member is providing the care.

### IN THE HEADLINES

- *Nearly 2 million veterans, or their widows, are likely missing out on as much as \$22 billion a year in pensions.*
- *VA has had only limited success in finding them, widows are hit hardest.*
- *Only 1 in 7 of widows, who probably could qualify, actually get the monthly checks.*
- *A VA study said, "...Veterans generally are completely unaware that the program exists."*
- *A VA pension official says, "But so many of these people—we don't know who they are, where they are."*
